Conditions of Vending:

1. Vendors must arrive within the time designated for the assigned booth and must be set up and ready for customers no later than 8 am. All cars must be moved from no parking spaces prior to 8 am.
2. Booth size is approximately 10ft x 10ft (no parking) or 10ft x 26ft (with parking). Spaces are limited and on a first come first served basis.
3. Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents, displays, etc. We also recommend providing bags or packaging for customers to conveniently carry their purchases.
4. Vendors are required to price their own items and make their own change. FMM is not responsible for collection of applicable sales tax.
5. Vendors agree to stay at their booth, or have someone manning their booth at all times.
6. Vendors agree to remain set up for the duration of the event. Tear down may not begin until after 12:30 pm.
7. FMM is not responsible for any loss or damage to merchandise or equipment brought by vendors.
8. No political literature or signage is allowed.
9. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products are allowed on the property. Smoking is not permitted on museum grounds.
10. Advance notice is required for cancellation. Vendor fees are non-refundable but can be applied to a future event (minus a \$10 administrative fee) if cancellation occurs more than 3 weeks prior to event.
11. FMM reserves the right to ask any vendor to leave (without a refund of fees paid) if their behavior or merchandise is deemed offensive, dangerous or misaligned with the ethics, mission or responsibilities of the Florida Maritime Museum.
